工業化農業與自然爭利作物產需系統亟待改善

Industrialized agriculture feeds millions of people around the world, however it does that at a cost. It hurts the symbiotic relationship between plants and insects. According to a new study recently published in the journal Nature, there is a link between climate change and industrialized agriculture. Because of that link, the practices of the industry threaten the survival of insects. That, in turn, threatens our food system.

工業化農業養活了全世界無數的人口,但成就這項壯舉並非毫無代價。大規模農業活動破壞了植物與昆蟲的共生關係。近日發表於《自然》期刊的新研究,首次將氣候變遷與工業化農業連結,指出兩者交互影響,威脅了昆蟲的生存,最終也危及了我們的糧食系統。

Insects help food grow. Even insects we hate, like biting midges, play an important role. They pollinate the cocoa plants we need to produce chocolate. In fact, according to the US Department of Agriculture, insect pollinators are responsible for about one-third of the human diet. Clearly, the need to redesign our food system is urgent.

A Dutch company is helping cities breathe by covering concrete buildings with moss. This plant absorbs CO2, filters out pollution, supports wildlife, and looks great. Moss is non-invasive to building exteriors because instead of roots, it has rhizoids. It also helps protect the walls from weathering, effectively extending the walls' lifetime.

The fossil of a dinosaur killed in an asteroid strike has recently been found, scientists claim. The dinosaur's limb, complete with skin, is just one of numerous remarkable finds emerging from the Tanis fossil site in the US state of North Dakota. Another key fossil uncovered is that of a sturgeon and paddlefish. The animals have pieces of molten rock from the asteroid impact stuck in their gills.

農業工業化 產糧不進反退 地力恢復刻不容緩

Insects aren't the only things suffering from industrialized agriculture. Even the soil itself is harmed because of the repeated overuse of land. The UN's Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) reported that half of the global population is suffering because of this, not only because soil is no longer fertile enough to grow food, but also because the global economy will suffer from not being able to produce as much.

昆蟲並非工業化農業的唯一受害者。由於土地反覆種植消耗,土壤亦深受其害。 聯合國防治荒漠化公約 (UNCCD) 的報告指出,全球半數人口正面臨工業化農業造成的土地退化威脅。此威脅不僅來自地力被掏空,無法種植糧食,更來自糧食減產導致的全球經濟動蕩。

Damaged soil can be repaired. By investing in large-scale land restoration, we can prevent and help reverse the problems of desertification, soil erosion, and loss of agricultural production. The report suggests that if over the next decade, some of the billions of dollars given annually to the fossil fuel and agricultural industries was redirected to improving soil health, roughly 1 billion hectares of degraded land could be restored.

失去地力的土壤還有機會恢復。透過有計畫的投資,將資金挹注於大規模土地恢復工作,以期防治、甚至扭轉土地荒漠化、水土流失與農業產能下降等問題。 UNCCD 的報告更指出,若在未來 10 年,將每年數十億美元用於化石燃料與工業化農業中的部分資金,用於改善土壤健康,預計將有約 10 億公頃已退化的土地恢復地力。

Feedback 計分卡促超市浪費減量

How do we begin to fight such a global problem as an outdated food production system? The first step is getting people involved. With headquarters in east London, Feedback is a campaign group of 20 food activists. Since 2013, they have been promoting a food system that is genuinely sustainable through a number of activities.

像過時的糧食生產系統,這樣的全球性問題,我們該如何對應?首先,號召群眾的參與。由20名食糧運動家組成,總部位於倫敦東部的Feedback,自2013年起,透過一系列的活動,推廣真正的永續糧食系統。

Among their many activities, Feedback publishes an annual food waste "scorecard". This ranks the policies and practices of the UK's top 10 supermarkets. Because of this, one supermarket chain called Tesco made a commitment to cut the amount of food waste in its supply chain by half. Feedback also ran a campaign called Total Bull, in which the food activists successfully convinced UK lawmakers to make real changes. They recently amended the Agriculture Bill to include powers to regulate misleading food labeling.



在 Feedback 推動眾多食糧行動中,年度糧食浪費「計分卡」是為英國十大超市的公司經營策略與實際作為進行評鑑,並公布其分析結果。該活動促使連鎖超市特易購 (Tesco) 承諾減少供應鏈中一半的糧食浪費。此外,在另一項「行銷謊言」的食糧運動中,Feedback 也成功地說服英國立法者做出實際行動,於近期修改農業法案的實際行動,並將規範誤導性食品標籤納入法律管轄。



新聞奧斯卡首頒

普立兹榮耀報導文學家

On the 4th of June 1917, the first Pulitzer Prizes were awarded. Joseph Pulitzer had made his fortune as a newspaper publisher. Before he died on October 29th, 1911, he wrote in his will that he would give \$250,000 to Columbia University to establish the Pulitzer Prize. His will specified that four awards would be in journalism, four in letters and drama, one in education, and four traveling scholarships.

1917年6月4日,第一屆普立茲獎頒獎。以發行報紙致富的約瑟夫 · 普立茲, 於 1911 年 10 月 29 日逝世前,他立下捐出 25 萬美元,供哥倫比亞大學創設 普立茲獎的遺囑。獎項包括 4 項新聞獎、4 項文學與戲劇獎,及 1 項教育獎與 4 項旅行獎學金。
